## About Us

[Open Education Alberta](#) (OEA) is a grassroots initiative, formally launched in March 2020 to provide OER publishing infrastructure in Alberta. The service uses a vendor-hosted Pressbooks digital publishing platform which is supported through a cost-sharing model by partner post-secondary institutions in the province of Alberta. Partner institutions provide local support to their faculty, staff, and students in the use of this platform for the publishing of openly licensed and adaptable content.

### Our Values

#### **Openness**

Open publishing values are the key focus of this initiative. This program reflects this value through supporting the creation and sharing of OER, and generally empowering members of our institutions to engage with open educational practices.

#### **Collaboration**

Partner institutions and their content creators will seek opportunities for inter-institutional collaboration for the creation of open content in order to build stronger relationships and communication among Alberta post-secondary institutions and reduce duplication of effort.

#### **Sustainability**

As an open publishing service, all partner institutions and their content creators will seek to model the best practices outlined by the open education community while considering the long term viability of our program.

Partner institutions and their affiliated content creators will strive to create accessible and inclusive materials that respect the diverse needs of users.

## Looking Back

### Summary of the Year

This year marked significant progress for Open Education Alberta (OEA), with notable advancements in outreach, website and resource development, and our first contract renewal for the shared Pressbooks Program.

- ★ **New General Membership:** This year saw the beginnings of a new membership structure to provide opportunities for non-Pressbooks Program members to engage in OER publishing activities and topics through a General membership option.
- ★ **Newsletter Outreach:** Organized by the Outreach Project Group, OEA introduced its first newsletter in June 2025. To strengthen our General member partnerships, newsletters will include titles from other post-secondary OER publishing programs in Alberta, including Athabasca University and MacEwan University.
- ★ **Website Development:** With the evolution of Open Education Alberta, the website was updated to reflect these changes in membership, governance, history, and to introduce a new space to share OEA's newsletters.
- ★ **Resource Development:** An internal Institutional Representative Toolkit was developed from existing resources and expanded into a more fulsome resource to better support institutional representatives and their local institutional OER publishing programs.
- ★ **Partnership Building:** Coordinated first Pressbooks Program contract renewal with The Alberta Library (TAL) and started to explore future possibilities.

These initiatives reflect our commitment to growing and sustaining a collaborative and well-supported open education community across Alberta.

### Spotlight on Members: NorQuest College

At NorQuest College, with 12 OER publications and 4 more in progress, their local service with Open Education Alberta supports the institution's Zero Textbook Cost (ZTC) mandate to reach 80% of courses by 2030. Already reaching 52% of credit courses, NorQuest learners have saved well over \$2.5 million due to ZTC since 2023.

strengthened through the coordination of a communication plan to improve engagement with current and prospective members.

- ★ **Showcasing Impact:** Work closely with institutional partners to explore ways OEA can measure and express impact at varying levels to support the initiative, institutional partners, and OER creators.
- ★ **Advocacy and Support:** Continue to advance resource and advocacy supports for institutions in response to changes in OER publishing, author needs, and needs of our members.
