<p>Exceeds Expectations: Excellent (A+, A, A-)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Fully addressed the topic and enriched the assignment by adding more elements from materials learned; length is appropriate (at least 25 seconds long); did not read off a script● Wide variety of vocabulary (vocabulary studied in class was used effectively); sentence structure shows good variety and complexity for current level● Excellent pronunciation for this level; clear and intelligible; presentation flows (not too many unnatural pauses)
<p>Meets Expectations: Good (B+, B, B-)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Fully addressed the topic; length is appropriate (at least 25 seconds long); did not read off a script● Good variety of vocabulary (vocabulary studied in class was used effectively); sentence structure shows good variety and complexity for current level● Very good pronunciation for this level; clear and intelligible; presentation flows (not too many unnatural pauses)
<p>Approaches Expectations: Satisfactory (C+, C, C-)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Generally addressed the topic; length is adequate (less than 25 seconds long); partially read off a script● Adequate, but fairly repetitive/limited vocabulary; some use of English; some invented words● Some frequently repeated pronunciation errors that interfere with comprehensibility; flow is hesitant with unnatural pauses
<p>Does Not Meet Expectations: Poor/Minimal Pass (D+, D)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Did not address the topic or in an insufficient manner; length is inadequate; read off a script● Inadequate vocabulary; frequent use of English; invented words or words that do not fit the context (making it hard to understand what the student is talking about)● Frequent pronunciation errors that interfere with comprehensibility; flow is very hesitant with unnatural pauses
